Justice Information Network Conference overview

Dennis Hausman, DIS, gave an overview of the conference that was held August 3, 1998. The conference was viewed as a great success and planning will begin soon for a similar conference to be held in 1999.

Office of Financial Management report/modifications to NCHIP assistance request

Bob Griessel from OFM reported that the original application requested 1 million dollars, the revised application is for \$730,000. A copy of that application was provided, which lists the specific requests and dollar amounts.

Bureau of Justice Assistance and Office of Management visit- Dennis Hausman

The Department of Justice is setting planning a working meeting to discuss integrated justice. Washington state has been invited to attend this meeting. It was learned that DOJ is hoping to set up to nine regional justice sites and Washington is being considered for one them. Anne Gardner from DOJ and Jim Bowman from OMB came to Washington state last month to discuss integrated justice with members of the CJIA and JIC.

Department of Justice Conference- Dennis Hausman

The Department of Justice is holding a conference in New Orleans on November 17th and 18th. Eight people from the State of Washington will attend as representatives of integrated justice. There will be 8 states represented in all at the conference. Four people from state government will be attending (Bob Lopez from the Washington State Patrol, Don Price from the Department of Corrections, Rick Coplen from the Office of the Administrator for the Courts and Dennis Hausman from the Department of Information Services) and four people from local government

(Tony Susinski representing the Washington State Association of Counties, Mike Vandiver representing the Washington State Association of Sheriffs and Police Chiefs, Steve Clem representing the Washington State Prosecuting Attorneys Association and Terry Humphrey representing the Association of County and Cities).

SEARCH Conference – Dennis Hausman

The Bureau of Justice Assistance and SEARCH are sponsoring a Symposium on Integrated Justice Information Systems on February 8, 9 and 10, 1999. The agenda was provided to the members.

JIN State Planning Workshop
